

Lil' Shaver Show Buds - Calf

This is an excellent opportunity to get youngsters started in showing cattle. This non-competitive showmanship will take place on Thursday at approximately 3:00p.m. at the Waupaca County Fair.

Rules

1. ShowBuds may show a calf already at the fair, or may bring their own calf between 2:00 and 2:30 p.m. on Thursday. Calves can be tied along the southeast corner of the show ring.
2. All animals must be in good health and follow all health regulations (as stated in the fair book). **Participants must fill out the Waupaca County Fair Animal ID & Vet check Information Form** (found in the fair book). This form needs to accompany the calf at the fair on Thursday.
3. Calves need to be born between March 1st and August 1st.
4. Classes will be divided by age. All participants must be between the ages of 4 – 9 (or 'up to' junior fair eligibility).
5. Children need to have a parent/guardian or older sibling at ringside or in the ring when the child and the calf are in the ring.
6. Pre-registered youth will be given a complimentary T-shirt to wear while they are showing.
7. Calves need to be clean, but not necessarily clipped.
8. Children will experience handling the calf and demonstrating the basic showmanship skills. The "judge" will ask each exhibitor a question or two related to the exhibitor and the calf. Examples include the following:
What is your name? What is the name of your calf? How old is your calf?
How much does your calf weight? What does your calf eat? Do you like showing at the fair?

Rules

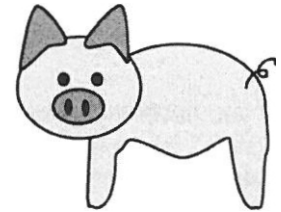
1. ShowBuds will show pigs provided at the fair.
2. Classes will be divided by age. All participants must be between the ages of 4 – 9 (or 'up to' junior fair eligibility).
3. Children need to have a parent/guardian, older sibling or junior hog shower at ringside or in the ring when the child and the pig are in the ring.
4. Pre-registered youth will be given a complimentary T-shirt to wear while they are showing. Youth registering at the fair may be given a T-shirt depending on availability.
5. Children will experience handling the pig and demonstrating the basic showmanship skills. The "judge" will ask each exhibitor a question or two related to the exhibitor and the pig. Examples include the following:
What is your name? What is the pig's name? How old is your pig?
How much does your pig weight? What does your pig eat? Do you like showing at the fair?

Rules

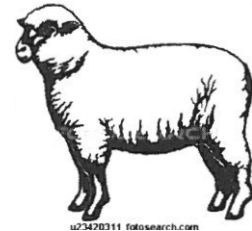
1. ShowBuds may show sheep already at the fair or may bring their own sheep between 1:00 & 1:30 p.m. on Friday.

4. Children need to have a parent/guardian, older sibling at ringside or in the ring when the child and the sheep are in the ring.
5. Pre-registered youth will be given a complimentary T-shirt to wear while they are showing.
6. Sheep need to be clean, but not necessarily shorn.
7. Children will experience handling the sheep and demonstrating the basic showmanship skills. The "judge" will ask each exhibitor a question or two related to the exhibitor and the sheep.
